KEY MESSAGES

Older People's Partnership Board

The partnership received a progress report from the Board setting out the work priorities for 2010-11, which include the dementia strategy, winter warmth/winter issues, loneliness and isolation, transport, information/advice and advocacy, and lifelong learning.

The partnership will consider future funding arrangements for the Board, and how it can continue to work with the Board to effectively plan service delivery for older people in North Yorkshire.

Local Area Agreement Q3 performance update

The five stretch targets carried over from LAA1 met their end of year targets for 2008/09 and at quarter 3 the ASP is on target to meet fully all but one of its 2009/10 targets. Work is ongoing to try and achieve the whole of the additional stretch target, which relates to extra care units occupied.

Draft North Yorkshire Housing Strategy

The partnership received details of the first Single Housing Strategy for North Yorkshire, which is being developed by the Local Government York and North Yorkshire Housing Board. The strategy is open for consultation until 19 March, and agencies can respond through the interactive website www.northyorkshirehousingstrategy.co.uk.
