KEY MESSAGES

Integrated Workforce Planning Arrangements

The group agreed that an Intergrated Workforce Planning Group should be set up as a sub group of the Adults Strategic Partnership. It will have multiagency representation and will look at issues like recruitment, retention, integrated working arrangements, and promoting strong leadership and management. Trudi Newell from NYCC Corporate Personnel Unit is leading on this work.

Quarterly LAA monitoring reports

The group looked at the first quarterly monitoring returns for the adults and healthier communities LAA targets. In general these were on track. However, not all targets have data available quarterly so it's difficult to get a clear picture. The delay in pump priming grant had also been an issue for some targets.

Joint Strategic Needs Assessment

The Commissioning framework for Health and Wellbeing requires local authorities and primary care trusts to carry out Joint Strategic Needs Assessments (JSNAs) to plan for future health and care needs. NYCC Adult and Community Services have already produced a 15-year strategic commissioning document. Using this as an exemplar approach, Cath Doman, Helen Christmas and Elaine Schofield will develop a way forward.
