NYSP Wider Partnership Conference 2009 – Planning Update

1 Purpose of the Report

1.1 To seek members' agreement to proposals for the allocation of exhibition space at the NYSP conference on 15th October 2009.

2.1 Following the level of interest shown in the small marketplace area at the 2008 NYSP conference, members will recall it was agreed in January 2009 that this element of the conference in 2009 should be widened out to offer the opportunity to a range of organisations to host a stand.

2.2 The Pavilions have advised that we should be able to comfortably accommodate 15 stands around the perimeter of the catering area. To maximise this opportunity it is proposed that the NYSP Executive agree which organisations or themes they feel should be represented within the marketplace area. Below are listed eight potential organisations/partnerships/themes for inclusion. The Executive are asked to agree these ideas and also consider others that they feel should be invited to host a stand. Initial enquiries have been made with the relevant officers/partners who would be responsible for the following stands:

- **Audit Commission;**
- **Housing** – to incorporate the Strategic Housing Board and info about extra care and housing for older people;
- **Local Strategic Partnerships** – potential for a joint stand has been discussed with LSP Co-ordinators;
- **North Yorkshire Credit Union;**
- **North Yorkshire Forum for Voluntary Organisations;**
- **York and North Yorkshire Waste Partnership;**
- **“Healthy Weight/Active Lives”** strategy – info and update on developments in promoting healthier communities;
- **Transport/Community transport in North Yorkshire** – potential jointly-hosted stand between NYCC and community transport providers; and

2.3 It is also recommended that the 95 Alive Road Safety Partnership roadshow vehicle be booked for an external display as this was well-received at the 2008 conference.

3 Recommendations

3.1 That the Executive agrees the above proposals for the NYSP conference marketplace and recommends additional ideas or an approach to filling the remaining seven stands.
