Recognised that due to different timescales for refreshing the SCSs it may take a number of years for the commonality to be across all 8 documents. Agreed that it would be difficult to achieve commonality for high-level vision statements as these need to be specific to the area covered and reflect the LDF. |
| 3.0 | PREVENT Update | The draft single countywide PREVENT action plan will be available by the end of October 2009. The joint bid for funding for workforce development was successful and a coordinated programme of briefings and training will commence later this autumn. |
| 9.0 | Future Jobs Fund | The Department of Work and Pensions (DWP) has advised that the bid to the Future Jobs Fund has been successful. In North Yorkshire this funding will create additional employment for young people through the development of a precursor to the established Real Start Apprenticeship Programme. The formal offer of funding from DWP will be provided once details have been submitted regarding the number of job starts that partners can commit to up to the end of April 2010. |
| 10.2 | Partnerships Governance (NYSP) | The drafting of a document firming up the governance arrangements for the NYSP Executive and Partnership by NYCC Legal Services has been delayed due to priority statutory work. In view of the considerations around the future of the NYSP Partnership (an initial discussion about this is scheduled at agenda item 11), it is proposed that this governance work be postponed until a decision has been taken about the NYSP structure. |
