

## City of York North Yorkshire Domestic Abuse Strategy 2009 to 2013 Feedback Report

A consultation exercise was carried out by the Domestic Abuse Coordinators and the Domestic Abuse Joint Coordinating Group (A Domestic Abuse Strategy Subgroup was set up) in York and North Yorkshire.

Presentations were given to the local domestic abuse forums in each District and a number of other boards and agencies (including North Yorkshire Housing Forum, Children & Young Peoples Scrutiny Group and North Yorkshire Supporting People Commissioning Group).

The Domestic Abuse Coordinators along with the Domestic Abuse Strategy Subgroup reviewed the feedback and updated the Strategy to include the responses. Comments were provided on the strategy documents but responses received on the Comments for Strategy Form were as follows.

I would reiterate the need for specialist DA Ch & YP Workers – equitable provision across the county – I would like to see mention of the longer term impact of DA on Ch & YP and the need for services to address this. Typing errors page 12 section 13 and 26 box at the bottom of the page	Typing errors changed.
The table on page 47 needs to be more description... how were these figures derived and what is included in Human cost. There is nothing on their for Older children who are perpetrator, as this only refers to adults in the definition, personally I think they should be included in this strategy.	There is no description as this was in the last strategy and there have been no amendments to the cost analysis at the time when the new strategy was developed. There is currently no formula available to find the cost of Older Children who are perpetrating Domestic abuse, however young people who perpetrate domestic abuse has been included in the strategy and the implementation plan.
Very positive, like the idea of early interventions particularly in schools so that warning signs can be detected.
