

ADULT STRATEGIC PARTNERSHIP (ASP) and HEALTHIER COMMUNITIES THEMATIC PARTNERSHIP (HCTP)

Joint Meeting of 12 May 2008

KEY MESSAGES

The partnerships received a progress report on LAA targets. All five ASP stretch indicators have met their first year targets. Excellent performance was reported in respect of ASP/6/(a) – Direct Payments. Monitoring of LAA1 targets will continue for the foreseeable future as this is required by the Government Office.

Indicators for LAA2 are in the final stages of negotiation. These will be submitted to ministers at the end of May for sign off by the end of June 2008. It has been confirmed that the LAA1 current stretch targets will be carried through to LAA2.

A proposed model for an Older People's Partnership Board was agreed, including terms of reference, reporting arrangements and the appointment of a chair for the first meeting, which will be held in October. Funding was agreed in principle and the process will begin while partners consider their funding contributions and further funding streams are explored.

The partnerships received a progress report on the North Yorkshire Joint Strategic Needs Assessment (JSNA) and agreed their contributions to the overall funding of the production of the JSNA. CYPS as the other key partner will be approached for its contribution.

The group received further details of the Better Government for Older People (BGOP) conference scheduled for 25th September at Pavilions, Harrogate. Derek Law will deliver a keynote item "Engaging with Older People". Anyone interested in attending is asked to contact Norma Sutton.
