Total Care – Partnership Working

The partnership received a presentation from Chris Anderson, Deputy Chief Fire Officer, regarding an initiative which aims to establish partnership arrangements with agencies (including social care services, police, fire and voluntary sector) in North Yorkshire to reduce risk to vulnerable members of the community.
